Notification of the date for the presentation of your artistic research proposal will take place by e-mail! The necessary materials required for this (see the next page) are to be submitted altogether with the application form as SINGLE PDF-FILE between 1st of February and 28th of February!

Instructions:

- a) Admission to the Artistic Doctoral Program requires prior completion of a Master’s degree or Diploma in an appropriate subject area at a recognized inland or foreign postsecondary educational institution, or a study program of equivalent nature.

If the equivalence is basically sound and only a few supplementary areas are missing to achieve complete equivalence, the Rectorate is authorized to require additional tests that must be taken during the doctoral study program to establish equivalency.

- b) Sufficient knowledge of the German language according to Level C1 of the European Standard for Languages (GER) or a comparably good command of the English language are to be demonstrated in the course of the presentation talk.

- c) Altogether with the Application form the following supporting materials are to be submitted for the presentation talk:

- An exposé of the artistic research proposal (languages: in German and/or English)
- Proof of prior scholarly and artistic achievements (including academic transcripts)
- Proof of qualified artistic professional practice (detailed CV)
- If necessary, proof of language competency
- Proof of the completed degree(s) or diploma(s)*: BA/MA diplomas, degree certificates, transcripts of records
- Pledge of acceptance from your KUG advisers

The Application and the supporting materials are to be submitted in digital form by e-mail (max. size of 19 MB for any mail incl. attachment; alternative: download link for Dropbox or Google Drive) between 1st February and 28th February (for the following academic year) to: doctorartium@kug.ac.at If the papers are not complete, then admittance is declined!

*Attention: In the case of foreign degrees, it is required that authorized copies of all supporting materials that have been issued by your home university as well as an official translation into German be submitted.
