

## **Brief Information about the Dr. artium Program at KUG**

The Doctor of Arts Program at KUG (degree: Dr. art.) as a rule lasts for six semesters and is to be carried out at the Doctoral School. Over the whole period of study, every doctoral candidate will be assigned a doctoral committee consisting of one artistic and one scholarly (academic) adviser from KUG, as well as one external artistic and one external scholarly (academic) adviser, all under the chairmanship of the Director of the Doctoral School.

### **Duties of the external adviser:**

- providing a written opinion about the artistic-scholarly qualifications of the candidate and about the exposé submitted at the time of admission
- providing an interim evaluation of the progress of the doctoral project made as a rule by the doctoral committee after the first year of the three-year study program in consultation with the external advisers (the costs for travel to Graz and lodging will be covered by KUG)
- providing the second opinion after the doctoral dissertation has been officially handed in
- collaborating as an examiner at the Rigorosum
